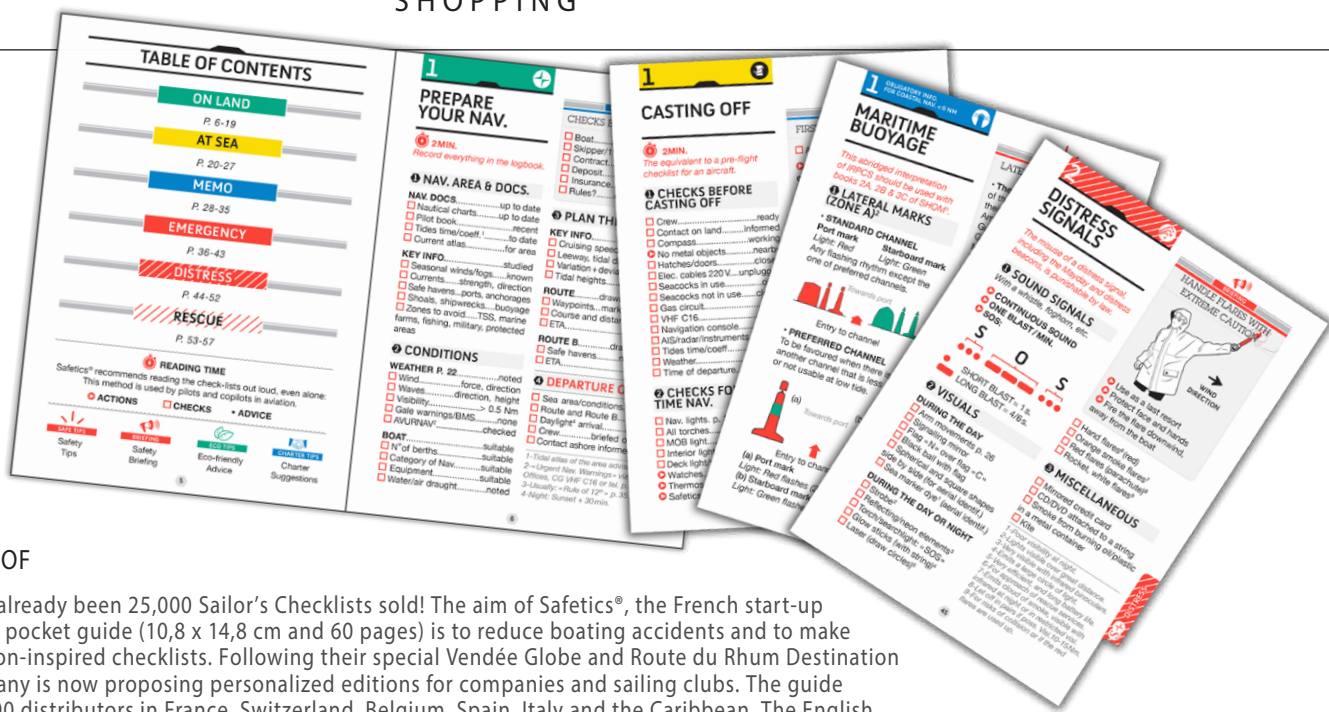

IKONVERT
A NEW CONVERTER
NMEA2000/NMEA0183

Digital Yacht has just put the finishing touches to its bidirectional converter, the NMEA2000-NMEA0183 which is designed to facilitate connection between networks. iKonvert is available in two versions: ISO (with NMEA0183 wires) and USB for PCs, Mac and Raspberry Pi. This new material is really useful for connecting instruments such as a chartplotter which doesn't have an NMEA2000 interface, to other equipment which has a NMEA0183 interface. One typical iKonvert application is to permit connectivity with an NMEA0183 interface. Another possibility is to be able to show data from a NMEA2000 network on a piece of sailing software. iKonvert can be easily configured with the integrated DIP switches, allowing for a host of different conversion modes which can handle any type of installation. Installation is easy. You just need to connect the iKonvert NMEA2000 cable to the NMEA2000 network, and the iKonvert will charge itself.

Reeds Weather Handbook

The second edition of this useful pocket size guide offers updates in terms of the use of GRIB files, computer weather modelling and sources of forecasts, including smartphone apps.

As well as highlighting the benefits of these, author Frank Singleton also covers their drawbacks and the reasons why it's still important to also consult a forecast that has had input from a human meteorologist. Singleton was a senior forecaster with the UK Met Office and is a boat owner with more than 50,000 miles' experience. This combination of experience and knowledge means the book is both authoritative and relevant to all of us who enjoy time afloat.

Safetics checklist

In the boating world we have generally been slow to adopt checklists. Yet in other fields, notably aviation, checklists have long been an important factor in reducing accident rates.

This led Safetics creator Guillaume de Corbiac, a keen sailor and private pilot, to produce a comprehensive safety checklist for sailors. It has sold 25,000 copies in France and is now launched in an English version.

Content includes outlines of the major navigation rules, plus a range of procedures validated by sea safety experts for activities including passage planning and pre-departure checks. It's designed for use by both sailing and powerboats and is printed on waterproof, tear proof paper.

Marsali Taylor reviews the latest nautical books

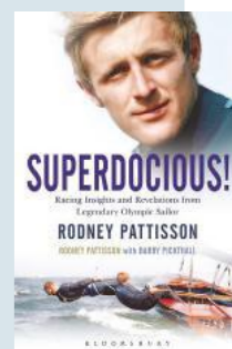
Superdocious!

by Rodney Pattison

In this enjoyable autobiography, Pattison tells the story of how he began sailing in Cadet dinghies and moved to the Olympic class Flying Dutchman. After three Olympic medals, he almost won the America's Cup, then graduated to offshore racing – including the 1979 Fastnet. The book's totally focused on his sailing, and it's only through the contributions from former crews and, particularly, his wife, Jane, that we learn much about Pattison as a person. His own narrative focuses on his intensive race preparations and the help he received from others. He also discusses the cheating at every level of sailing, and gives suggestions for how this could be countered.

A readable, instructive and inspiring account of what made Pattison a world-class sailor.

Cutty Sark: The Last of the Tea Clippers

150th Anniversary Edition by Eric Kentley

This handsome softback covers every aspect of Cutty Sark, beginning with the history of the tea trade for which she was built, and the race to London to be first with the cargo. Her design and construction are detailed, then her voyages, cargo, masters and crew during her tea-clipper days. Her years under the Portuguese flag, her return to England, her life as a training ship and finally her restoration are all described in detail, and with a wealth of illustrations. As often with specialist museum publications, I found the print small and had real difficulty with reading text printed in black on sepia, which comprised about a third of the book. Fascinating and detailed.
